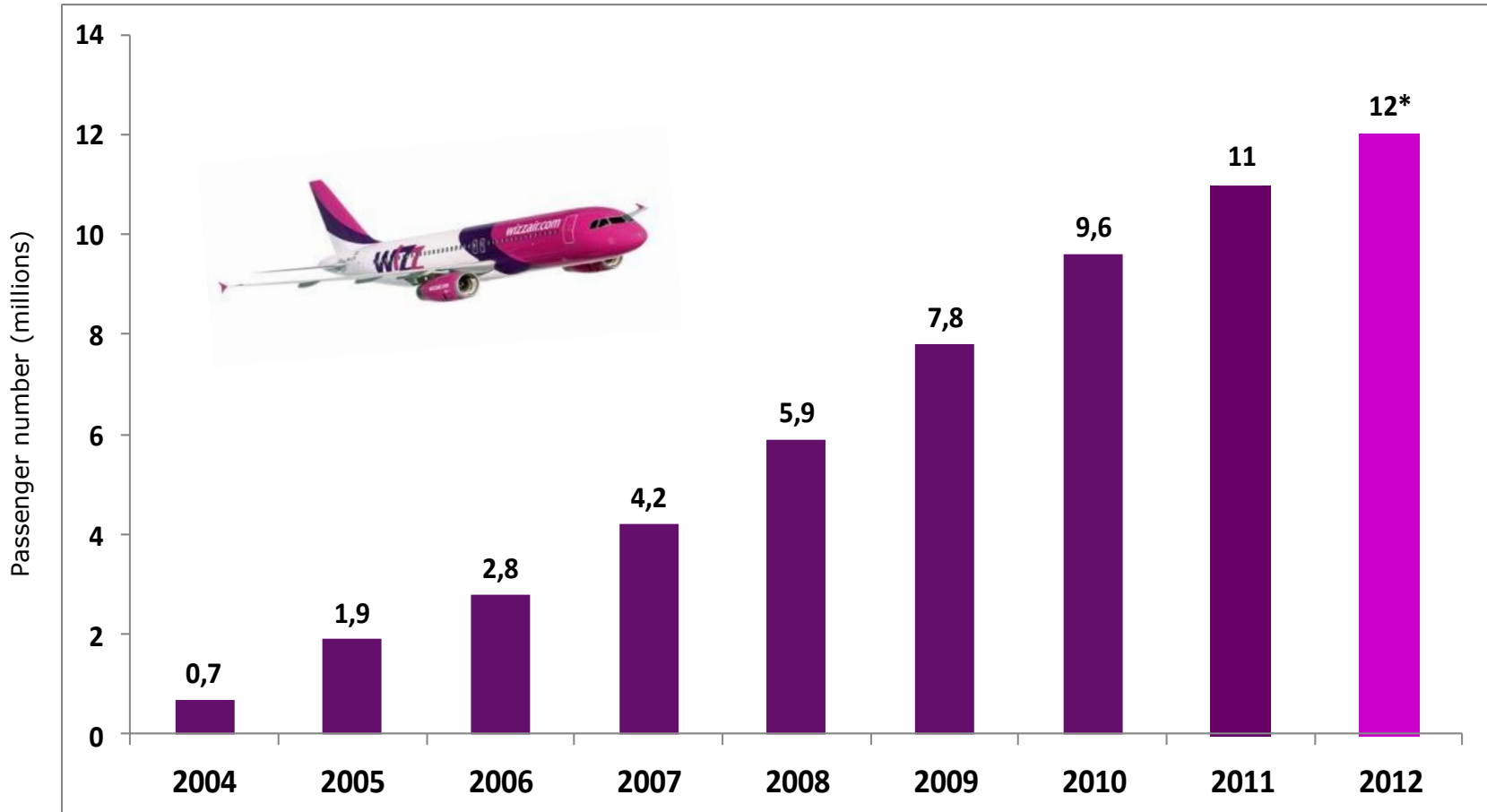

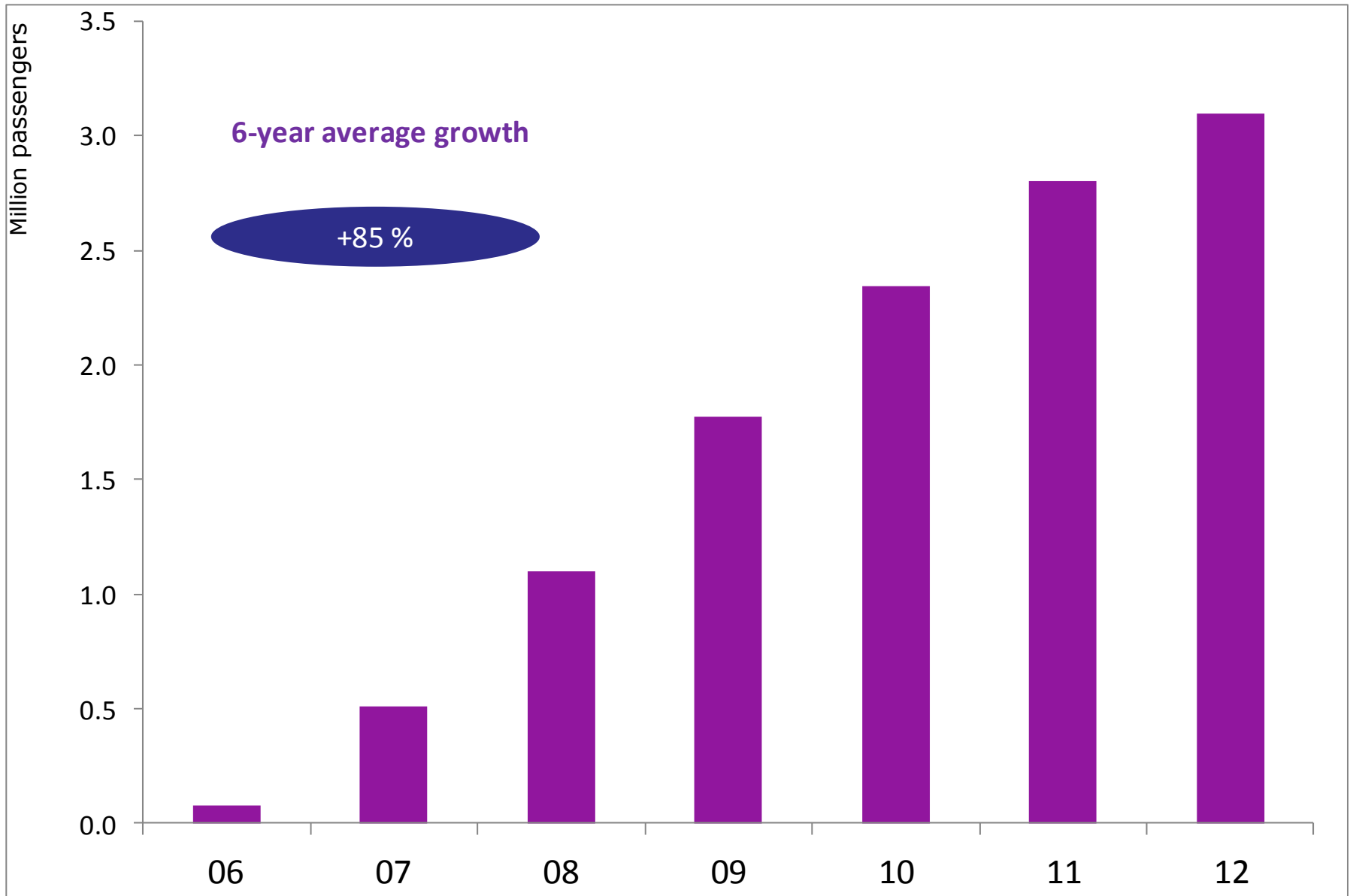

Wizz Air passenger traffic growth in Romania

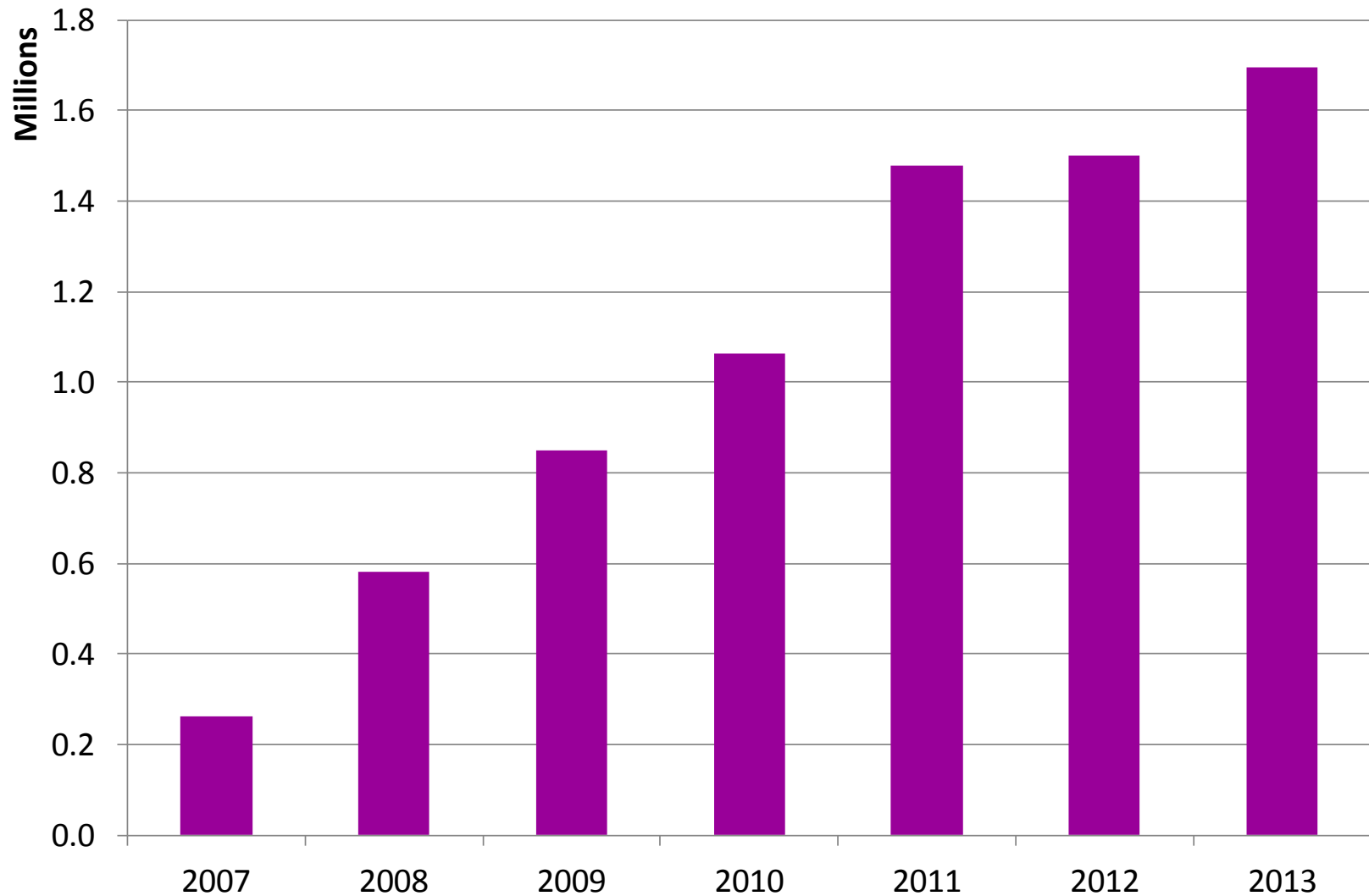

Wizz Air new routes in Bucharest



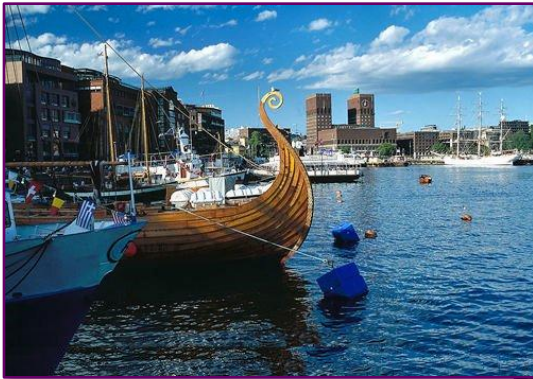
